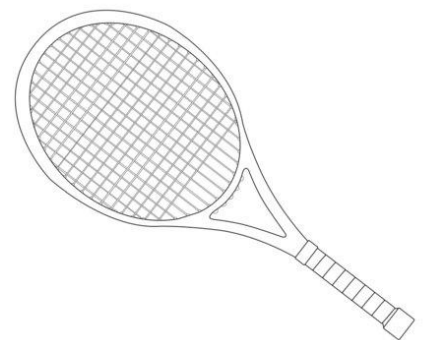
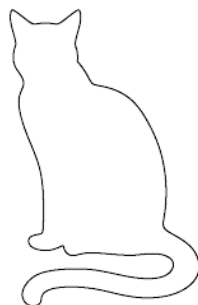
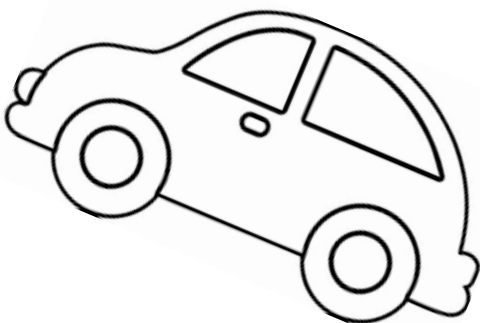
Last Month we welcomed Jo to the staff team, Jo is our new Kitchen Manager and we are very glad to have her on the team!



We also welcomed Denesia to the health care assistant team who has been fantastic!

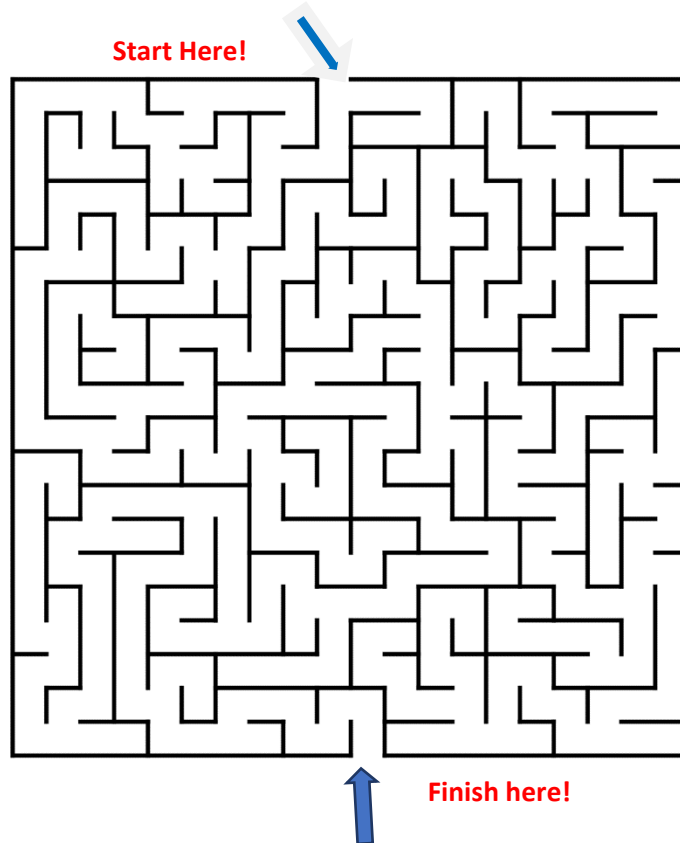
Did you know?
